They also offered lots of advice which we thought we would share with you all.



Uses machines such as pacemakers and octoate capita to fix problems with the heart.





- He works for a company called Lobb Shoes. He makes the last of the shoes, which is the wooden framework of the shoe.


Some of us made a shoe last out of clay!

We learnt the many materials that shoemakers use, like lizard skin, crocodile skin and leather.




